This survey was carried out a bit earlier than usual and as the season is late the balance of different types of butterflies is a bit different but the species are what would be expected (apart from one orange tip which is rather early for second brood).

The very large numbers of **meadow browns** is typical of this time of year in grassland as are **ringlets**. **Gate keepers** have only just emerged – almost all were seen at the top of the back steps in field two.

The really good news is the numbers of **marbled whites** particularly in field 2. The second most common butterfly recorded!

Before the recent hot sunny weather butterfly numbers were low because of the cold April and wet May.
