

The following is a list of Mammals living on, seen or reported to have visited the Millennium Green since 2000

Mammal	Resident or visitor	Comments
Grey Squirrel	Resident	Often seen around the moat boardwalk on fence and in trees
Rabbit	Resident	Rabbit holes in both fields; more rabbits seen in the second field.
Mole	Resident	Plenty of mole hills evident
Field vole	Resident	Not often seen but tunnels in grass found
Fox	Regular frequent visitor	Sometimes seen in early morning
Badger	Regular visitor	Old badger set in second field has not been used for a long time. Badges sometimes dig into ant hills.
Muntjac deer	Occasional visitor	Have been observed an Footprints seen
Roe deer	Very occasional visitor	A roe deer spent a few days in the second field
Water shrew	Rare	One was seen once on the inner bank of the moat
Weasel	In the area and will visit if not resident	One was seen 'mesmerising' a rabbit
Stoat		Seen near the Green
Shrew	Probably resident	Dead one seen
Rats and mice	Although none seen or reported they will certainly be present	

Update:

Rats became a problem around the moat about 2019 due to too much food being left over from people feeding the ducks. 2 or 3 could be seen at a time and they showed little fear of humans.
