Curved slasher
Straight slasher
Two fairly heavy-weight loppers.
2 scythes
Scythe (donated by Mark R)
Metal rake (donated by Mark R)
Hedge planter – for use with cell grown whips
One three-pronged steel rake (originally intended for dragging weed from the ponds).
'Muck rake' – hooked rake useful for getting stuff from moat and dragging bramble
Part of electric fence : about 25 blue poles, reel of wire, 2 metal spikes.
(missing - the pulse maker – the expensive bit; also it would need new battery)
Inflatable boat with paddles (donated by David W)
Grapling hook (belonging to Graham M)
Some nails, staples, coach bolts and red and white tape
Various old tree guards and canes
